There is a house in my neighborhood that spooks me. Many say there hasn't been an occupant for over


What are the CONTEXT CLUES?

There is a house in my neighborhood that always spooks me. Many say there hasn't been an occupant for over 20 years. I am unsure how long no one has lived there, but I think it's haunted.

I can tell an occupant someone who lives in a place by the words that are after the vocabulary word.

The first few slides are teacher examples. Use these slides to show your readers where to find context clues in the text.

WAYS TO USE:

Print the task cards on cardstock and laminate them for best use. Place the task cards in a baggie for storage and convenience.

You can use them in different centers around the room or in small groups.

If the task cards are laminated, have the reader underline the context clues with an Expo or Vis-à-Vis marker so that they can visualize where context clues are located in the sentence.

Additionally, these task cards are great for use around test prep time, in tutoring, over the summer, or for homework.



After practicing context clues, test your reader's knowledge using the quiz at the end of the packet. The teacher can easily track and show the student's performance.

This resource is great to use in parent conferences for additional data.
