






Perfect for independent reading time to monitor comprehension.





Print the questions and ask students during any stage of the book.

Pre-print reading response sticky notes to use as kids' independent read.


The sticky notes are EDITABLE.







The reading responses can also be cut and glued inside a reading notebook or to the top of a piece of paper. This is a good way to check students' understanding.


Have them complete and use them as an exit ticket.
